Individual checks for the scholarships will be made out to each student. These checks will be presented at the annual Dover Area High School Alumni Association (DAHSAA) picnic, in May.

DAHSAA Scholarship Recipients will be expected to attend the annual DAHSAA picnic lunch at Brookside Park on, Sunday, May 1, 2022, where they will be introduced to the DAHSAA members, who work hard to raise money for these scholarships. All members of the scholarship Committee will read all applications. The scoring is based purely on a point system.
