implementation. This allowed us to meet as a Tier 2 PBIS team to review how successfully we are implementing PBIS at the Tier 2 level, which focuses on providing students with more individualized supports for academics and/or social/emotional needs. We received a score of 84.62%, which means that we qualify for Tier 2 Recognition at the state level for our implementation of PBIS. The meetings proved to be very helpful in providing next steps for our committee for next year.

In thinking about next year, we are always looking for parents to come to the PBIS meetings in the mornings. We will continue to meet monthly on Tuesday mornings at 8:10 next year!
